Faith Team gathered the following information about what our pupils have learnt about our value of 'Respect' this half term.

"Respect is about caring for others and helping people in any way we can." Y6 pupil

"We have to respect everyone." YR pupil

"If we treat people the way that we want to be treated, they will treat us respectfully too." Y2 pupil

"Respect is linked to the British Value – Mutual Respect, we should respect everyone even if they are different to us and have different ideas or faiths." Y6 pupil

"The Good Samaritan was a good example of how to show mutual respect, because the Samaritan helped the Jewish man, even though they didn't often agree on their faith and beliefs." Y3 pupil
