Faith Team gathered the following information about what our pupils have learnt about our Christian value of 'Trust' and British value of 'Democracy' this half term.

"Trust takes years to build, seconds to break and forever to re-build...except that because we forgive, it won't take us forever to re-build." Y3 pupil

"If someone shows that they trust you, you should respect that trust and not break it." Y4 pupil

"We learned about Moses and the Red Sea, God said that we should trust and everyone had to trust Moses when he parted the sea." Y5 pupil

"We learned that we have people who we completely trust, some people who we trust in the community because they are there to keep us safe (like the police) and then other people who we trust because of their role (like hairdressers), but we don't trust all of them to know private things about us because we don't really know them." Y2 pupil

"Christians believe we should trust in God with all of our heart." Y6 pupil

"Our Christian value Trust links to Democracy, because in the UK we vote for the government and decisions we want made and then we have to accept and trust in who was chosen to care for our country." Y4 pupil

"During Covid, we had to show trust in the government and what they asked us to do...it can be hard though when you don't really understand why." Y3 pupil

"We follow a democracy in school – we vote for roles we want and responsibilities like House Captains and Faith Team." Y5 pupil

"Trust is very important, if you couldn't trust anyone then you would live a lonely life and be very worried all the time." Y1 pupil
